When Wall (Timeline)

Use the "[When Wall – Purple Cards Key](#)" file to do the When Wall cards at home. Review the Historical Heading cards ("purple cards") that tell the story of the Bible. This week scramble the purple cards and have your child tell the story of the Bible as he/she puts them in order. For Kindergarten and up add in the Famous People cards (white cards) and for 2nd grade and up add in the Books of the Bible cards (yellow cards).

Lesson

As you introduce the lesson, talk about where in the Bible timeline this lesson occurs (which purple card this lesson falls under). See the [Life-When Wall](#) answer key for guidance. "God became flesh" and "Jesus raises the dead" go under the "Christ: GOD's Great Plan" purple card. Tell carefully or read dramatically today's lesson using the Bible and your child's lesson folder. Make sure you use some sort of visuals as you teach the lesson, here are some [lesson 11 visuals](#) created by Renee! *Remember to emphasize how God is the hero of the story.*




FACTS TO KNOW

WHO: Jesus, Jairus, Jairus' daughter, Mary, Martha, and Lazarus

WHEN (Purple Card): Christ: God's Great Plan

WHERE: Bethlehem, Galilee, Sea of Galilee, Capernaum, and Bethany

WHAT: God had a plan before the world began. That plan is Christ, Jesus. Jesus is our perfect example. When we become Christians, we need to be Christ-like. Isn't God Loving?

Family Study Questions:

Make this a study for your entire family!

Read scriptures listed at beginning of lesson.

1. Why was the woman healed who touched Jesus in the crowd? What did she have that caused her to be healed when she touched Him?
2. How can we have faith like hers today?
3. Why was Jesus willing to go to Jairus' house, even though there were people telling Jairus that it was too late. Why did Jairus allow him to come, even though he was told that his daughter was dead?
4. Why did Jesus delay in going to see Lazarus when He was told that Lazarus was very sick?
5. If Jesus knew that He was going to raise Lazarus from the dead, why did He weep with Mary and Martha?
6. Why should Jesus' reaction to Mary and Martha's sadness give us comfort?

Lesson	Marching Drill – Start with : Left, Left, Left, Right, Left
1	<i>God made light and water for me. I thank Him now for all I see.</i>
2	<i>I love God: He is so great! He will make an end to hate!</i>
3	<i>I will follow night and day. God's my light he leads the way!</i>
4	<i>Jehovah is my strength and song! I will praise him all day long!</i>
5	<i>I will not complain and doubt. God provides I'll sing and shout.</i>
6	<i>I will not fear enemies. God my God, will fight for me.</i>
7	<i>I will fight for God my King. He is stronger than anything.</i>
8	<i>GOD made ME for LIFE not DEATH. I'll praise GOD while I have BREATH.</i>
9	<i>GOD can bring the DEAD to LIFE. I will NOT fear GUN or the KNIFE.</i>
10	<i>When I DIE because I SIN GOD can GIVE me LIFE again.</i>
11	<i>Jesus, Hero, GOD'S own SON. YOU'RE my HOPE of resurrection!</i>
