Text: Exodus 12

Memory Verse: Psalm 146:5,7

## FACTS TO KNOW

**WHO:** Moses

**WHEN (Purple Card):** Moses

**WHERE:** EXODUS; Egypt, Nile River, Goshen, and Canaan

**WHAT:** God was setting His people free. They had to follow the plan that God had made for them. He always keeps His promises. We always have to obey. Isn't God great?

Open My Eyes that I may see ... the Passover Lamb, who died for me!

## When Wall (Timeline)

Use the ["When Wall – Purple Cards Key"](#) file to do the When Wall cards at home. Review the Historical Heading cards ("purple cards") that tell the story of the Bible. For Kindergarten and up add in the Famous People cards (white cards) and for 2nd grade and up add in the Books of the Bible cards (yellow cards).

3. What is the name of the feast that God had the Israelites observe after the feast of the Passover? How were the Israelites to prepare for that memorial?
4. How do we eat unleavened bread today?
5. Figuratively, is the bread from the Lord's Supper similar in any way to the unleavened bread that the Israelites ate in their feasts? Why or why not?
