

**Text: Joshua 5:10-12**

**Memory Verse: K-3<sup>rd</sup>: Psalm 145:15  
4<sup>th</sup> -5<sup>th</sup>: Psalm 145:15-16**

## FACTS TO KNOW

**WHO:** Joshua

**WHEN (Purple Card):** Joshua & Judges

**WHERE:** JOSHUA; Moab, Mt. Nebo, Shittim, Jordan River, Canaan, Gilgal, Jericho

**WHAT:** The Promised Land! The land flowing with milk and honey. The Israelites did not need manna anymore. They were home. Isn't God good?

## When Wall (Timeline)

Use the [“When Wall – Purple Cards Key”](#) file to do the When Wall cards at home. Review the Historical Heading cards (“purple cards”) that tell the story of the Bible. For Kindergarten and up add in the Famous People cards (white cards) and for 2nd grade and up add in the Books of the Bible cards (yellow cards).
