Lesson 21: ISAIAH & EZEKIEL TEACH VALUABLE LESSONS ABOUT BREAD

Text: Isaiah 55:2-3, Ezekiel 16:48-30, Matt. 25:31-46, John 4:30-38

Memory Verse: John 4:34

Dear Parents, A Giver and Taker of Bread is our God! Talk to your child about God's justice. If we do what is right, God will reward us, but if we do what is wrong, God will punish us.

Prayer & Praise

Praise Verse: **Psalm 107:9**

Use the praise verse to praise & lead to into prayer!

He gives those who are thirsty all the water they want.

He gives those who are hungry all the good food they can eat.

Theme Song: "Break Thou the Bread of Life"

Theme Psalm: Psalm 23

Open My Eyes that I may see ...
Feeding others is good for me.

When Wall (Timeline)

Use the "[When Wall - Purple Cards Key](#)" file to do the When Wall cards at home. Review the Historical Heading cards ("purple cards") that tell the story of the Bible. For Kindergarten and up add in the Famous People cards (white cards) and for 2nd grade and up add in the Books of the Bible cards (yellow cards).

Lesson

As you introduce the lesson, talk about where in the Bible timeline this lesson occurs (which purple card this lesson falls under). See the [Bread-When Wall](#) answer key for guidance. This week's lesson **Isaiah** goes under the "Kings" purple card on the "Judah" side and **Ezekiel** goes under "Homesick Heroes". Tell carefully or read dramatically today's lesson using the Bible and your child's lesson folder. This week praise God while telling about good King Hezekiah & the prophet Isaiah using the [interactive lesson 22 visuals](#) created by Renee (please read the "Note to Parents" on the 2nd slide). *Remember to emphasize how God is the hero of the story!*


FACTS TO KNOW

WHO: King Hezekiah, Isaiah, King Manasseh, Amon, Josiah, Hejoahaz, Jehoiakim, Jehoiachin, Ezekiel

WHEN (Purple Card): Kings & Homesick Heros

WHERE: Tigris and Euphrates, Isarael "cross out," Assyria - cross it out, Judah, Jerusalem, Babylonia, Babylon

WHAT: God tried to keep the Israelites on the right path. Sometimes they would follow Him, and sometimes they would not. Isn't God right to punish wrong doing?
