The Israelites Defeat the Egyptians just by Traveling






As the people watched, Moses walked right up to the edge of the Red Sea. Then Moses did something that God had told him to do. He lifted up his rod and a strong wind began to blow.

The wind cleared a path, right through the middle of the sea. The Children of Israel followed their leader in between those huge walls of water.






When the Israelites were safely on the other side, God told Moses to stretch out his hands over the Red Sea again and the waters returned together.




None of the Pharaohs army survived. God had another VICTORY by his people following his plan and traveling.

# Moses Defeats the Amalekites by Holding His Arms Up!



The Israelites were traveling in the wilderness. The Amalekites, came up behind them to attack.




Moses called Joshua to choose some strong fighting men to go out and fight the Amalekites the following day.




Moses told them he would stand on top of a hill with the staff of God held high in his hands.




Moses held his hands up. While Moses' hands were held high, Joshua and his men were winning the battle.
