David Beats Goliath








Long ago, in the land of Judah, the Israelites and the Philistines were bitter enemies.

David played the lyre for King Saul. The lyre is a small harp.






King Saul was worried that David was too small to fight such a big warrior. David told the king that God would protect him. Then the king gave David his own armor. When David put it on, he could hardly walk.


David took off the armor and picked up his shepherd's bag and sling.




The stone struck
